It's one o'clock

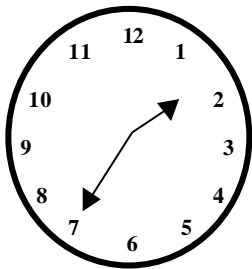
